

## EY Lead Practitioner (EYLP) Role

***Do you have a passion for making a difference in the Early Years and at least 5 years' experience in an EY role, including 2 years' experience at a supervisory or managerial role***

This is a specialist role for colleagues in a non-teacher position. As an EYLP you will be sharing your Early Years expertise and experience with colleagues in other settings to support EYs practice. This is a really exciting opportunity to be a supportive part of the wider local educational community and for your own Professional Development

### What would this involve?

Following a successful application and interview process, you would then be asked to visit other EYs providers who are seeking support. You will also be asked to assist with our Aspiration Networks and the creation/delivery of training & CPD to support the sector. The frequency of the work would be subject to local demand and would be agreed by your Manager/Headteacher. To remain designated as an EYLP you would need to complete at least 1 piece of work within 2 academic years.



### Is this a paid position?

The role is not salaried, but Warwickshire TSA would cover the cost of your time out by paying your setting/school an agreed, national, daily supply rate.
